

The Changings in 19 Mayıs İlkokulu, Denizli-Turkey After EFPAS Project

EFPAS Project work at 19 Mayıs İlkokulu is based on basic Eco-friendly attitudes, knowledge and behaviors. This Project work has contributed to our school community (school staffs, school students and parents) positive impact. In this case;

-Eco-team was built from 4th grade class. This team is responsible for organizing Eco-friendly work at school such as preparing presentations about Eco-issues to inform the students at schools about Eco-life issues.

- The Eco-friendly activity that is related to select the cleanest classroom of week has been sustaining since 2017.

-A school hobby garden was built by school staffs and students. This activity has been sustained since 2017.

- The craft activity prepared Eco-toys from waste materials became hobby.

-Waste collection exhibition has been organized every year since 2017.

-Workshops have been done to make students gain separation of waste materials for two years.

-Local food festival with parents' support is organized in every December for two years.

-In spring seasons, Hidrellez Festivals with various traditional dance and games is organized to welcome the spring. There is an intensive interest to join in this festival after EFPAS Project.

-World Eco-days celebrations have become more colorful for two years.

The joint in Eco-friendly activities has intensively flourished between Kindergarten age students and upper age students since two years.

In addition to all, the desire of collaborative work with European schools on Environment issues in the school students, school teachers and parents has folded twice than expected.
